WHAT DOES CALDWELL SUTTER CAPITAL, INC. DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. What we do			
How does Caldwell Sutter Capital, Inc. protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.		
How does Caldwell Sutter Capital, Inc. collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account or make deposits or withdrawals Direct us to buy securities or sell securities Discuss your portfolios and financial situation with us		
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. Definitions			
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Caldwell Sutter Capital, Inc. has no affiliates.		
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Caldwell Sutter Capital, Inc. does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you. However, we do share information with the custodian of your account in order for them to service your account.		
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Caldwell Sutter Capital, Inc. doesn't jointly market.		

Other important information

For California Residents: In accordance with California law, we will not share information with nonaffiliates, except as allowed by law. For example, we may share information with your consent or to service your accounts.

For Nevada Residents: We are providing you this notice pursuant to state law. You may be placed on our internal DO Not Call List by calling 800-326-7141.
